

## Remote Area First Aid

### Course Summary

---

This course is designed for those who require training that conforms to the recommendations of the Australian Resuscitation Council and provides the knowledge and skills to provide first aid to a casualty in a remote and/or isolated situation where emergency services may not be able to respond for extended periods.

This course incorporates the content of: HLTF301B Apply First Aid

### National Course Code

---

HLTF302A Provide First Aid in a Remote Situation (from the Health Training Package HLT07)

### Delivery

---

The expected duration to complete this course is 24 hours training and assessment. This is achieved via the same methods as the Apply First Aid course with an additional 8 hours of face to face practical training and assessment, meaning this a 2 day face to face course.

### Content

---

All content contained within Apply First Aid with the addition of:

- Preparation for isolated work and/or travel
- Communication systems
- Evacuation and transportation procedures
- Prolonged casualty care
- Improvise treatment and resources

### Award Issued

Participants must be 14 years or older
