

Manage First Aid in the Workplace (Occupational)

Course Summary

This course is designed for those who require training that conforms to the recommendations of the Australian Resuscitation Council and extends from Advanced First Aid to address the establishment and maintenance of facilities to enable or facilitate the provision of appropriate first aid in the workplace.

This course is designed for people employed as Occupational First Aiders, normally on a site with more than 100 employees and/or has a First Aid Room. This course is accredited and approved by NSW WorkCover.

This course incorporates the content of: HLTF301B Apply First Aid

HLTF402A Apply Advanced First Aid

HLTF404A Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques

Delivery

The expected duration to complete this course is 32 hours training and assessment.

This is achieved via students completing part of the theory prior to attending using either our on-line facility or we can send a workbook and manual and then a further 3 days of face to face training and assessment.
